CSC REQUIREMENTS

Requirements:

1. Your boat must have a valid OH registration decal.
2. Your boat must be in sailable condition. Any repairs to make it sailable must occur within the same sailing season. Extensive repairs should occur off club grounds.
3. Your boat must be secured while on club grounds:
 - a. WINTER: The boat and mast must be secured on the trailer.
 - b. SUMMER: The boat must be secured to the shoreline with stakes.
 - c. YEARLY: The boat must carry insurance for any damage your boat can cause.
4. Two (2) club workdays per year.
One is during the year to maintain and improve property, buildings and grounds and the 2nd is to do Hoover Reservoir cleanup. Workdays are a requirement in our lease with the City and an essential part of being a member. Failure to comply can result in fines or loss of membership.

Social Events:

The club sponsors 3 social events each year. Make use of the club grounds for your family outings. Portable Toilet service, grills, sail storage, trailer parking are provided.

CSC HISTORY

The Columbus Sailing Club was founded in the late 70's as a racing fleet within the Hobie Class Association. The club grounds are leased from the City of Columbus. Membership has ranged from 10 to over forty boats during the clubs existence. Our club has evolved from a racing format to that of family pleasure sailing.

On the grounds we have created a sailing beach from a large briar patch, constructed a shelter, storage areas, and trailer parking area. The shelter area is screened in with available gas grills for picnics. Toilet facilities are available.
